EMERGENCY PROTOCOL FOR LIVE FAUNA IN SAMPLES

If you detect or suspect live fauna in a sample:

- 1. Immediately seal the box of bag(s)
- 2. Double bag the sample and seal securely
- 3. Disinfect your work area with the approved biocide spray
- 4. Inform Prof. Morrison or Post-Doc in lab
- 5. You will need to decide if the sample is still useful and if the treatment will affect it
- 6. If the sample is too badly damaged to be useful or cannot be frozen then it should be incinerated
- 7. If the sample is still of value, then it should be immediately placed in the -40°C/-40°F freezer for at least 7 days (this may damage flotation samples!!!)
- 8. If you have multiple samples from the same site these should also be checked and treated if necessary
